

Health Facilities at IISER Berhampur**1. OPD Consultation and treatment from Dispensaries operating at both transit and permanent campuses**

IISER Berhampur Health Center currently operates on two campuses in two separate Dispensaries, catering to the primary healthcare needs of members of the IISER Berhampur community.

The Dispensary at the transit campus serves students, staff, and family members (registered dependents of regular staff) and is staffed with one Medical Officer and two Nursing Officers.

The Dispensary at the permanent campus serves students and staff and is staffed with two duty Medical Officers and four Nursing Officers.

An ambulance is available on campus 24x7. Round-the-clock medical services are available in the permanent campus dispensary.

A visiting consultant Psychiatrist's services are available once weekly on campus. In addition to this, a counselling psychologist is available on both campuses as a counsellor. Round the clock online counselling support via Yourdost platform is also available for the staff and students at IISER Berhampur.

2. Cashless medical treatment from empaneled hospitals

The Institute has signed MoUs with the following hospitals at Bhubaneswar for health care management (available for all regular employees & eligible dependents' family members) on a cashless basis as per the existing CGHS tariff (refer to CS(MA) Rules, 1944) for OPD consultation and treatment as indoor patients.

- I. KIMS Hospital Bhubaneswar
- II. SUM Ultimate Medicare Hospital Bhubaneswar.

3. Empaneled Diagnostic Centre at Berhampur

The Institute has signed an MoU with Nidan Diagnostics, Berhampur. According to the MoU, Nidan will carry out lab/radiological investigations for the referred cases from IISER Berhampur at a mutually agreed rate/discount of 20%.

4. Free Annual Health Check-ups for regular staff

IISER Berhampur offers free Annual Health Check-ups (AHC) for all regular employees once a year (on their birthday) to promote health maintenance and disease prevention. The AHC comprises a general physical examination and blood investigations. The general physical examination will be performed at the Institute Health Centre, and blood investigations will be conducted at Nidan Diagnostic Centre, Berhampur.

5. Medical reimbursement for regular staff and eligible dependents as per CS(MA) rules.

Regular employees of IISER Berhampur and their dependent family members are eligible for medical reimbursement as per the CS (MA) rules of 1944 of the Government of India, restricted to CGHS Bhubaneswar rates prescribed for the specific treatment purpose. All the eligibility/entitlement criteria for various treatments, medical attendance rules, and treatment norms will be as per the CS (MA) rules.
