

Health Facilities at IISER Berhampur

1. Health Center

IISER Berhampur has a Health Centre on campus that caters to the primary healthcare needs of the IISER Berhampur community.

The Health Centre (HC) on campus is an 8-bed primary health centre with OPD services, a minor OT, an emergency room, and an inpatient ward, and it functions round the clock. The Health Centre serves students, staff/and family members and is staffed with two Doctors and five Nursing Officers on a shift basis. A Basic Life Support ambulance is available on campus 24/7.

The following visiting specialist services are also available at the HC. Psychiatrists (Twice weekly), Medicine Specialist (Once weekly). Dermatologist (Once weekly).

Student counselling services are also available at the HC. A team of two student counsellors, including a qualified Clinical Psychologist, is available for the same. Counsellors work in conjunction with Institute Psychiatrists and the Medical team to ensure the mental health and well-being of the fraternity. Round-the-clock online counselling support via the Amaha platform is also available for the staff and students at IISER Berhampur.

2. Cashless medical treatment from empanelled hospitals/Diagnostic Center

The Institute has signed MoUs with the following hospitals at Bhubaneswar and Berhampur, as well as a Diagnostic Centre at Berhampur for health care management (available for all regular employees & eligible dependents' family members) on a cashless basis as per the existing CGHS tariff (refer to CS(MA) Rules, 1944) for OPD consultation and treatment as indoor patients.

3. Medical reimbursement for regular staff and eligible dependents as per CS(MA) rules.

Regular employees of IISER Berhampur and their dependent family members are eligible for medical reimbursement as per the CS (MA) rules of 1944 of the Government of India, restricted to CGHS Bhubaneswar rates prescribed for the specific treatment purpose. All the eligibility/entitlement criteria for various treatments, medical attendance rules, and treatment norms will be as per the CS (MA) rules.
