Applications are invited for the Ph.D. program (Walk-In Interview) in the Department of Chemical Sciences. Kindly fill out the Google Form and upload the Application Form, relevant documents in the Form along with the Application Fee Receipt.

- Indian Nationals can apply only through online mode of application. The **deadline for application** in online mode is **July 12, 2025**. Please note that this is a hard deadline. No further extension would be made. Go to "[Google Form Link](#)"
- Download the attached application form and letter of reference with this notification.** You need to upload the filled-out Application form and letter of reference in the same Google Form.
- PhD applicants may arrange for two letters of reference as well. For this purpose, the names of the referees along with their e-mail addresses are to be provided by the candidate at the online applications portal. The referees will be contacted electronically.
- Application fee:** There is no application fee for PhD admissions.

Minimum Qualification:

- (i) The application must have a Master's degree in the relevant subject or a Bachelor's degree in Engineering or Science (4-year programme) with marks/CPI not below 60%/ 7(on a 10-point scale) CPI.
 - (ii) **The candidate must have qualified for CSIR / UGC JRF/ DST INSPIRE or any other external fellowship**
- M.Sc./MCA/M.Tech. Degree in the relevant discipline with a minimum of 60% marks or CGPA/CPI of 7.0 on a 10-point scale. (Overall percentage/ CGPA/CPI; not only in majoring subject)
 - A relaxation of 5% of marks, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, will be allowed for candidates belonging to SC/ST/PD categories.
 - If the transcript/grade sheet issued by the Institute/University reports:
 - Only marks, percentages will be considered.
 - Only grades, CGPA/CPI will be considered. If CGPA/CPI is reported on any scale other than 10 (eg. 4 point/ 8 point scale), an equivalent CGPA/CPI will be calculated as per the following formula: $\text{CGPA/CPI in a 10 point scale} = (\text{CGPA/CPI Obtained} \times 10) / \text{PS}$ PS = Point scale used by the Institute/University.
 - Both marks and CGPA/CPI - the percentage equivalent of CGPA/CPI, as indicated on the transcript/grade sheet, will be considered, if absolute grading is followed. d. CGPA/CPI ONLY will be considered, if the relative grading is followed.

- Self-attested proof for award of fellowship from the funding agency
- Date of Birth (DOB) certificate
- All the original mark sheets/ grade transcripts and certificates starting from class 10th, for verification
- Copies of mark/grade sheets for the qualifying degree (required for all semesters/years)
- Original Government Photo ID and certificate of SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PD/EWS, if applicable
